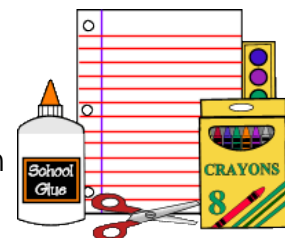

WNC Participates in National Night Out

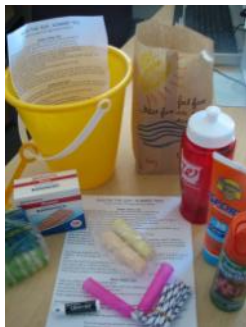
