## LIMITS TO LAUNDRY SOAP



This is just a reminder that you are **ONLY able to get 6 bottles of laundry soap each YEAR**. We intended it to be distributed every other month, but with the new punch cards you can receive it as you need it. YOU NEED to pace yourself. **Once your 6 punches are gone, that's it until September 2009**. Please note that a small bottle of laundry soap should last you 2 months, and a medium to large bottle or box of soap (which is most of what we give out) should last 3-4 months.
