Make your own laundry soap! (reprinted by request)

1/3 bar Fels Naptha
1/2 cup Arm & Hammer Super Washing Soda
1/2 cup 20 Mule Team Borax Powder

You will also need a small bucket, about 2 gallon size

Here's What You Do:

Grate the soap, put in a sauce pan. Add 6 cups water and heat it until the soap melts. Add the washing soda and borax; stir until it dissolves. Remove from heat. Pour 4 cups hot water into the bucket. Add your soap mixture; stir. Add 1 gallon, plus 6 cups of water; stir. Let the soap sit for about 24 hours and it will gel. Stir before each use. Use 1/2 cup per load.
